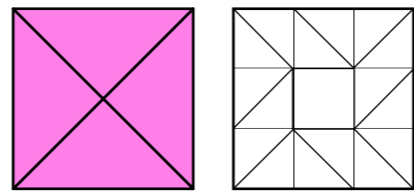


Coaster



1. Begin white side up.

2. Fold bottom edge to diagonal crease.

3. Like this.

4. Fold point A to point B, make a small crease at top.

5. This is one third.

6. Fold the edge to meet the third.

7. Fold the other edge to meet fold from step 6.

8. Fold the bottom edge to meet the intersection of third.

9. Fold top edge to meet fold from step 8.

10. Sheet is divided into thirds.

11.

12. To make the mountain fold turn over, remember point A.

13. Fold point A across the smallest square. Turn over.

14. Completed mountain fold.

20. It will look like this pinwheel. Turn over.

21.

22. Fold point along existing crease.

23. Fold the next point on top of the last.

24. Again...

25. Fold the last point, then unfold and tuck it under the first point to lock the coaster.

26. Completed Coaster.

19. Repeat step 18 on sides 2, then 3, then with 4. The last side needs to be woven to sit flat.

18. Assembly. Make the first creases as shown.

17. Completed crease pattern.

16. Repeat steps 11-15 on the 3 remaining sides.

15. Unfold to see the result. Turn the model 90 degrees.
